
Your Stewardship Supports

Fundraisers, like our successful Holiday and Spring Bazaars, involve almost everyone in the Church. We are famous locally for our beautiful greens and crafts. The Social & Environmental Action Committee guides our exploration and deeper understanding of issues facing our local and global communities with film series, concerts, and Sunday Services.

Our attractive building, known as the West Village Meeting House, is rented to organizations whose missions complement our own. We host the New England Youth Theatre's inclusive *Theatre Adventure Program* for actors with and without disabilities, Brattleboro Women's Chorus, concerts, art shows, meetings, and rites of passage.
